 - Arranging shoes in the shoe rack
 - Filling the water bottles.
- ❖ Imbibe 'Social Skills' in your child. Encourage your child to...
 - Greet with a smile when someone comes to the house
 - Converse feely with visitors, relatives coming over to the house
 - Speak politely and share with peers.
 - Sit at the dining table with the family to eat meals using proper table manners. Do not watch television while having meals with the family.
 - Share toys, colours with siblings
 - Respect and help the elders at home
 - Water the plants
 - Keep your surroundings clean
