






Fill the clouds by dabbing the black colour using cotton balls. Then make stars with white colour by using ear buds.


Let's make a beautiful night cloud.




Pick up your colourful crayons and colour the picture below.




Colours play a vital role in our lives and how we respond to our surroundings. The colours you surround yourself with can influence your perspective and emotions, as well as those around you.

Fill the colours in Rainbow to make it beautiful as you are.









Concept of Big/Small

Children look to their fathers to lay down the rules and enforce them. They also look to their fathers to provide a feeling of security, both physical and emotional.


Make this day special by doing something for your Father & let him know that how much special he is in your life.

As we did cold cooking in our class, prepare something special for your Dad and serve him:




